

Generation Next Scholarship Application

For Academic Year 2026-27

Scholarships of up to \$2,500 annually, funded through charitable donations, are available to qualified Generation Next students who graduate (or are about to graduate) high school and are attending (or planning to attend) a postsecondary educational institution. Factors that are considered include academic achievement & promise, enrollment plans, financial need, educational cost unmet by financial aid, and student loans. Although renewal of scholarships is not guaranteed, scholarship recipients are encouraged to reapply on an annual basis.

To be considered for a scholarship, you must:

- Be accepted to an undergraduate degree/certificate or vocational program at a college, technical or trade school and know which school you will/want to attend OR be currently enrolled full-time as a postsecondary student.
- Demonstrate exceptional promise & financial need.
- Submit this completed application by June 1 (before the start of the academic year). Applications received after this date may or may not be considered, depending on timing & available funds.
- Attach copies of the following documents:
 - your FAFSA Submission Summary (the result of your processed 2026-27 FAFSA, all pages)
 - your postsecondary school's current financial aid award letter/offer
 - your most recent academic transcript
 - your postsecondary school's current term bill or account statement, if available
