Need Help Completing Your FAFSA? Have Questions About Applying for Financial Aid? Want Personalized Guidance from a Financial Aid Expert?

Moravian University is hosting free Saturday workshops to help you complete your FAFSA-Free Application for Federal Student Aid, in partnership with Community Action Lehigh Valley. You and your parents are invited to take advantage of this special opportunity, brought to you by the Financial Aid Committee of CALV's Generation Next Advisory Board.

WHAT:

Fill out and transmit your 2024-25 FAFSA electronically, with help from financial aid professionals who will answer your questions and assist you in getting it right. University iPads and network connections are on site and ready to go. Light breakfast and refreshments will be provided, along with optional campus tours and information sessions.

WHERE: DATE:

Moravian University, Main Street Campus (North), Bethlehem

Your choice: January 20, February 3 or February 17

TIME:

FAFSA sessions begin at 9 am and 11 am. Plan to arrive and check in at least 15 minutes before your session, and be sure to identify yourself as a Generation Next student. It should take about 20 minutes to complete the FAFSA, although you may have to wait for a seat depending on attendance. If you want to learn more about Moravian University and/or go on a campus tour, allow another 1-2 hours after your FAFSA session.

DO I NEED TO SIGN UP? Yes. <u>Use this link to register online</u>. Don't be confused, the workshops are offered during Moravian's "Saturday Tour and Information Session" events. You must select one of the above dates and times. Please ignore all other listed dates and times. Select "FAFSA" if you see this option listed; otherwise choose "MAIN CAMPUS TOUR" (and when you check in, you will be directed to the FAFSA session in the same building).

DIRECTIONS & PARKING:

The location on campus appears on the registration pages, along with parking directions and a campus map. Friendly guides and signs at parking lots and along sidewalks will help make sure nobody gets lost.

HOW SHOULD I PREPARE? You will need to make a StudentAid.gov account by creating your Federal Student Aid-FSA ID. Your parent(s) will also need their own FSA ID. FSA IDs should be created as soon as possible before attending the workshop. <u>Click here for how to create an FSA ID.</u>

WHAT SHOULD I BRING? Bring your FSA IDs, along with copies of 2022 Federal Income Tax Returns. Even though your tax information will be transferred directly into the FAFSA form, you may still need your tax records to answer certain questions.
